Half rabbit, half...?



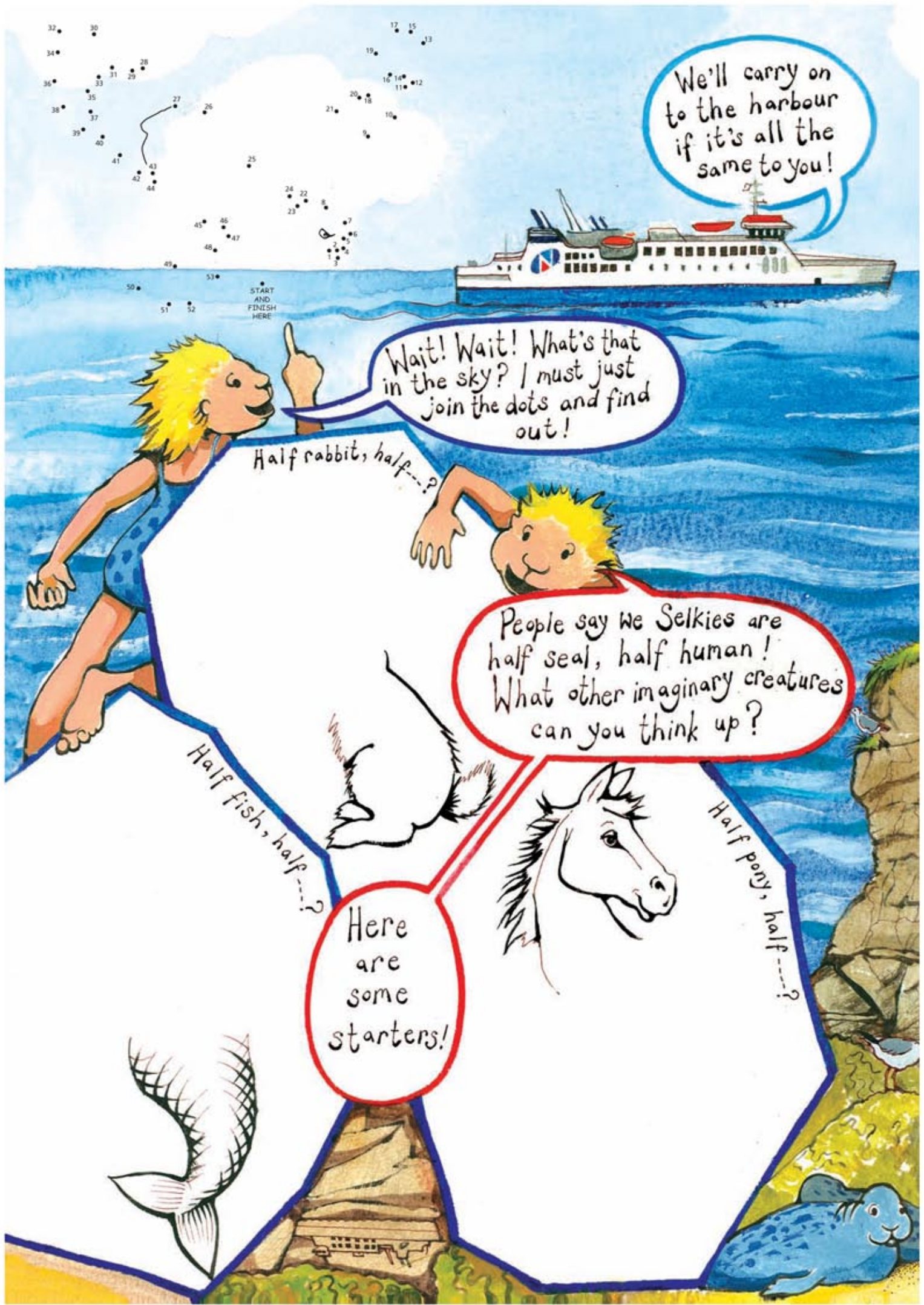
People say we Selkies are half seal, half human! What other imaginary creatures can you think up?
